Subject: Upgradation of Government ITI s in the State of ASSAM under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Establishment of Industrial Training Institutes (ITI s) in the North Eastern States and Sikkim"- Procurement of Equipment and Furniture in New ITIs .

Sir,

This has reference to the earlier orders wherein sanction of the President was accorded for Rs. 2,52,50,000/- for procurement of Equipment vide order of even No. dated 29.9.2003 under the scheme "Establishment of New Industrial Training Institutes (ITI s) in North-Eastern States and Sikkim" in the state of ASSAM.

I am now directed to convey the sanction of the President for the release of **Rs. 14.56 lakh (Rs. Fourteen lakh Fifty six thousand only)** to the State Government of ASSAM for the purchase of equipment (computer items) for the New ITIs , as per the following details.

2. The release of Central fund of **Rs. 14.56 lakh (Rs. Fourteen lakh Fifty six thousand only)** in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions :

(i) The equipment/furniture purchased should be strictly in accordance with the standard list of tools and equipment, as prescribed by NCVT for the particular trade or as per the list prescribed under "Project 150" of CSTARI, Calcutta for Short Term Courses under the approved scheme.

(ii) The grant shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.

(iii) The amount sanctioned should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.

(iv) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating component-wise expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the Directorate General in Duplicate.
