Subject: Sanction for civil works in 7 ITIs in the State of UTTAR PRADESH under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) of "Upgradation of training infrastructure in 100 Govt. ITIs".

Sir,

This sanction is in continuation to this ministry's letter of even No. dated 30.12.2005, wherein sanction was accorded for Rs. 210 lakhs as central share for the construction/ renovation work in 7 ITIs under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) of 'Upgradation of training infrastructure in 100 Govt. ITIs', releasing Rs. 52.50 lakhs as first installment to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh.

I am now directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of 50% of the central share amounting to **Rs. 105.00 lakhs (Rupees One Hundred Five Lakhs only) as second installment** to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh for the construction/ renovation work in 7 ITIs, as tabulated below, under the CSS :

2. The release of Central fund of **Rs. 105.00 lakhs** to the State Government of UTTAR PRADESH in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions:

- The ITIs should be renovated or constructed in accordance with the NCVT approved space norms and estimates prepared by PWD or State approved agency.
- The grant shall be utilized keeping in view the guidelines of the Scheme/ MoU and only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.
- The grant should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
- IMC clearance must be obtained before initiating bidding/tendering for civil works.
- The work shall be awarded after open competition / bidding / tendering through PWD / State approved agency.
- The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A in respect of individual ITI indicating expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the DGE&T in Duplicate.
