**Subject:** Upgradation of ITIs in the State of **Himachal Pradesh** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Upgradation of ITIs into Centres of Excellence"- Equipment Procurement for BBT/Advanced Module Training in existing ITIs: regarding.

Sir,

This is in continuation of this Directorate General's sanction letter of even No. dated 29<sup>th</sup> March 2008 vide which Rs 42.20 lakh (**Rupees forty two lakh twenty thousand only**) were released as 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of Central share for procurement of Equipment for the three ITI of **Himachal Pradesh** under the scheme "**Upgradation of ITIs into Centres of Excellence**" under BBT/ Advanced training **during** the Financial Year 2007-08.

(2) I am now directed to release a further amount of **Rs 37.45 lakh (Rupees thirty seven lakh forty five thousand only)** equivalent to 80% of the central funds towards **1<sup>st</sup>+ 2<sup>nd</sup> installment** to the State Government of **Himachal Pradesh** for the purchase of equipment for BBT/ Advanced modules for the above ITIs as per the details given below:

3. The release of Central fund **Rs 37.45 lakh (Rupees thirty seven lakh forty five thousand only)** in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions:
- The equipment purchased should be strictly in accordance with the standard list of tools and equipment, as prescribed by NCVT for the particular trade as per State Purchase procedure/DGS&D / State Rate Contract.
  - The grant shall be utilized keeping in view the guidelines of the Scheme/MoU and only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.

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- (iii) The amount sanctioned should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
  - (iv) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating component-wise expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the Directorate General in Duplicate.
  - (v) After making purchases, bid documents, bids, bid evaluation reports and letter of award should be retained by the State Directorate for post-award review by DGE&T.
  - (vi) IMC clearance should be obtained before procurement of equipment.
5. The sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with the pattern of assistance approved by the Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance.

**Subject: Upgradation of 100 ITIs into Centers of Excellence – Release of funds under "Other Charges - regarding.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey sanction of President to incur expenditure not exceeding **Rs. 29.38 lakh (Rupees twenty nine lakh thirty eight thousand only)** as Central Share under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Up-gradation of training infrastructure in 100 Government ITI s" for the **three (3) ITIs** in the State of **Himachal Pradesh** for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year, for which training has been commenced in 2005-06, as per the details tabulated below. The cost towards corresponding State Share will be borne by the State government as per the MOU signed between the Central and the State Government.

2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the President for the release of **Rs. 29.38 lakh (Rupees twenty nine lakh thirty eight thousand only)** to the State Government of **Himachal Pradesh** in respect of the said scheme under the component "Misc./other expenditure, is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The grant shall be utilized for various identified activities viz. Instructor /Staff training, raw materials salary of contractual staff/guest faculty, office expenditure, workshops etc.
- (ii) The release of Central fund **Rs. 29.38 lakh (Rupees twenty nine lakh thirty eight thousand only)** in respect of the said scheme is subject to the condition that the activities which directly relate to the training in COE should be given first priority viz. expenditure on contract /guest faculty, training to Staff Books for the library, raw material, training material etc. The Expenditure should be strictly in accordance with the approved norms. Wherever norms are not available, same could be prepared and got approved at the appropriate level
- (iii) The grant shall be utilized keeping in view the guidelines of the Scheme/MoU and only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.
- (iv) The amount sanctioned should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
- (v) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating component-wise expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the Directorate General in Duplicate.
- (vi) The expenditure statement and related documents should be retained by the State Directorate for post-award review by DGE&T.

(vii) IMC clearance should be obtained before making expenditure.
