- d. IMC clearance must be obtained before initiating bidding/tendering for civil works.
- e. The work shall be awarded after open competition / bidding / tendering through PWD / State approved agency.
- f. The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A in respect of individual ITI indicating expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the DGE&T in Duplicate.
