Subject: Upgradation of ITIs in the State of KARNATAKA under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Upgradation of 100 ITIs into Centres of Excellence". Equipment procurement for Broad Based / Advanced Training in existing ITIs regarding.

Sir,

This has reference to the letters of even no dated 20.12.2005, 29.03.2006, 23.3.2007 & 05.03.2008 wherein sanction of the President was accorded for an amount of Rs. 337.50 lakhs (Rupees three crore thirty seven lakh and fifty thousand only) and release of Rs. 252.57 lakhs (Rupees two crore fifty two lakh fifty seven thousand only) of central share for procurement of Equipment for six ITIs of Karnataka State under the scheme "Upgradation of ITIs into Centers of Excellence" under BBT and Advanced training during the Financial Year 2005-2006, 2006-2007 and 2007-08.

2. I am now directed to sanction an amount of Rs 162.90 lakh and release an amount of Rs. 224.32 lakh (Rupees two crore twenty four lakh and thirty two thousand only) of the central funds towards the part of 1 & 2nd installment for procurement of Equipment in the six ITIs of Karnataka under the scheme "Upgradation of ITIs into Centres of Excellence" under Advanced training during the Financial Year 2008-2009.

3. The release of Central funds of Rs. 224.32 lakh (Rupees two crore twenty four lakh and thirty two thousand only) in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The equipment purchased should be strictly in accordance with the standard list of tools and equipment, as prescribed by NCVT for the particular trade as per State Purchase procedure/DGS&D State Rate Contract.

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- (ii) The grant shall be utilized keeping in view the guidelines of the Scheme / MoU and only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.
- (iii) The amount sanctioned should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
- (iv) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating component-wise expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the Directorate General in Duplicate.
- (v) After making purchases, bid documents, bids, bid evaluation reports and letter of award should be retained by the 'State Directorate for post-award review by DGE&T.
- (vi) IMC clearance should be obtained before procurement of equipment.

4. The sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with pattern of assistance approved by the Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance.
5. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Account:-

Major Head "3601" – Grants in –Aid to State Governments:

- .04.321 Training Grants
- .03 Other Schemes
- .03.04 Upgrading Training Infrastructure in 100 Govt. ITIs.
- .03.04.31 Grants in Aid

and will be met out of the budget grant of FY2008-2009.
